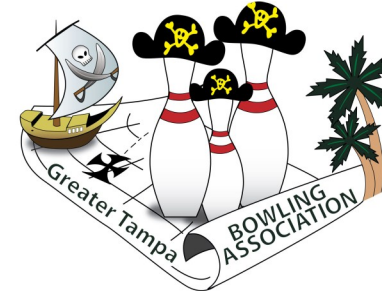


Tournament Rules - (continued) -

5. Teams and Doubles may be composed of any combination of boys and girls. There will be a boys and Girls division Singles and All Events only.
6. All participants will bowl three (3) games in each event.
7. Teams and doubles will bowl in order listed on the entry form. Substitutes may be used and will bowl in the same line-up position.
8. Bowlers entering doubles must enter Singles. Bowlers entering Singles must enter Doubles. **SINGLES EVENT WILL BE BOWLED FIRST.**
9. Bowlers may enter Team Event twice, but no more than two (2) original bowlers may bowl together on the second team. A bowler may also substitute on two (2) additional teams. The first team and the first doubles scores bowled will count for ALL EVENTS.
10. Bowlers entering average will be current yearbook average of 21 games or more. If no yearbook, summer average of 21 games or more. If no yearbook or summer average, bowler will use highest average of 12 games or more at the starting date of the tournament. **ALL OTHERS WILL BOWL SCRATCH. ALL AVERAGES MUST BE VERIFIED BEFORE THE BOWLER ROLLS THE FIRST BALL FOR SCORE. IF NOT VERIFIED, THE BOWLER WILL BOWL SCRATCH. THERE WILL BE NO EXCEPTIONS.**
11. Falsification of average or information may result in disqualification of the bowler and or team.
12. All Entrants must report at least 45 minutes before assigned squad time. Bowlers must check-in themselves (COACHES MAY NOT CHECK-IN FOR THE BOWLERS). If any changes and/or substitutions are to be made, the Coach must report to the Tournament Manager at least one (1) hour before the squad time, except in cases of emergency.
13. In the event a full team is not present at the scheduled time to bowl, the members present shall have the option of accepting a qualified substitute, if one is available. Once the substitute has started the first game, the substitute will finish the entire series. Such substitutions shall be made by the Tournament Manager. **NO BLIND OR VACANCY SCORES WILL BE USED IN THIS TOURNAMENT.**
14. Awards will be given on a ratio of one (1) for every eight (8) entries. Awards for all Events will be: First Place Scratch and First, Second and Third Place Handicap, Boys and Girls. Only one (1) All Events trophy may be earned with Scratch taking precedence. In the case of a tie for First Place, duplicate awards will be given and co-champions will be declared.
15. Any appeal or protest regarding scores or eligibility shall be made in writing to the Tournament Manager within 72 hours after the error or infraction has occurred.
16. The official scores will be kept by official scorekeepers or by automated scorekeeping devices. **ALL CHANGES MUST BE MADE BY THE OFFICIAL SCOREKEEPERS. ONLY BOWLERS AND TOURNAMENT OFFICIALS WILL BE ALLOWED IN THE BOWLING CIRCLE.**
17. All entries will be processed and squad times assigned on a "First come, First serve" basis.
18. **THERE WILL BE NO UNUSUAL OR UNNECESSARY DELAY BY ANY BOWLER.** Any bowler found to be causing any unusual or unnecessary delay will be disqualified from the tournament immediately.
19. **THERE WILL BE NO TELEVISION SETS, RADIOS, CELL PHONES, PAGERS OR ANY OTHER DISTRACTING DEVICES allowed on the concourse or in the bowling circle during the tournament.**
20. **TEAM NAMES MUST BE COMPLETE NAMES, NO INITIALS OR ABBREVIATIONS WILL BE ALLOWED, THE TOURNAMENT MANAGER WILL CHANGE ANY TEAM NAME DEEMED UNSUITABLE WITH USBC YOUTH STANDARDS.**

SMART SCHOLARSHIPS FOR 1ST PLACE / USBC YOUTH TOURNAMENT RULES

1. ALL USBC TOURNAMENT RULES AND REGULATIONS WILL APPLY. There will be no use or consumption of tobacco products or intoxicants by any USBC member WHILE ON THE PREMISES. All contestants will exhibit good sportsmanship. Failure to do so will result in disqualification of the bowler or team. Any formal disciplinary action will result in suspension. ALL contestants shall be properly attired - NO HATS, HALTER TOPS, TANK TOPS, BARE MIDRIFTS, or SPANDEX CLOTHING WILL BE WORN. Shorts and skirts will be allowed, but they must not be more than 4 inches above the bend of the knee. * NO SHORT SHORTS * Youth participants will not wear apparel or use bowling equipment depicting alcohol, tobacco, gambling, an illegal substance or inappropriate language/gestures during competition.
2. Entry into this tournament is open to all USBC members within the geographical boundaries of the Tampa USBC.
3. Entrants will be placed into the divisions on the basis of average; regardless of age. All divisions will use the handicap of 90% of the difference between the bowlers average and 200. Bowlers will qualify for USBC awards earned in their average division. Center Coaches will apply for all awards.
4. Events will be: Team (4 members), Doubles, Singles, and All Events.
